## Curbside Pickup

is a tremendous convenience  
**It is for household trash only**

**Not for recycling or bulk**

---

**This increases our curbside pickup cost**



**We are charged extra for this**



*Please – do the right thing*

Household trash should be placed at the curb after dusk the night before pick-up in securely tied, heavy-duty plastic bags (NOT in cans).

If you're leaving town, please don't leave your trash bags at the curb for days. Please take your trash to the maintenance enclosure before you leave.

Curbside collection does NOT include Recycling or bulk waste. These items must be brought to the maintenance shed enclosure.

# At the Maintenance Enclosure

## HOUSEHOLD TRASH DISPOSAL

### For **BAGGED** HOUSHOLD TRASH only

- If the front bins are full please use one further back.
- Please do not drop your bags on the ground or on top of bins.
  - No tires, paint cans, electronics, appliances.



*Please – do the right thing* (The rear toters were empty)

# At the Maintenance Enclosure

## RECYCLING DISPOSAL

### What can be recycled?

- Paper
- #1 and #2 Plastics (not plastic bags)
- Cardboard **Folded boxes only (no Styrofoam)**
- Aluminum, Metal Cans
- Glass

If it does not meet the criteria above, it is NOT recycling.

*Please – do the right thing*

**This may feel like plastic, but it is furniture**



# At the Maintenance Enclosure

## HOUSEHOLD BULK WASTE DISPOSAL

- Only open Wednesday, Thursday or Friday **IF** space available
- **Do not overfill or it will not be picked up.**
- Do not place items next to the dumpster.
- NOT for appliances, tires, paint or flammable waste or large furniture

*Please – do the right thing*

## QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

Large items not appropriate for the maintenance dumpster, such as sofas, TVs, appliances, mattresses etc. must be taken to a Queen Anne's County Transfer Station **by the Unit owner.**
