In order to avoid frozen pipes and to allow Maintenance to finish installing faucet protectors on the hose bibs:

- 1. turn off the water to your outside hose bibs from the inside shut off,
- 2. remove any hoses that are attached,
- 3. drain the water that may be in the line and
- 4. leave the faucet open.
