Decks, balconies repair deadlines - ACTION needed from unit owners with structures noted with safety issues:

We are finalizing a plan to offer a community contract for balcony/deck repairs and hope to have detailed information circulated next week. In the meantime, we want to advise you that:

- The deadline to complete repairs will be March 2025;
- By December 13, 2024, please submit to the Office a signed contract for your repairs or proof of your repair completion, so that we can incorporate all others into the community contract.
- On December 3rd, we will hold a Special Board meeting to discuss the balcony/deck repair project.

Deadline and Instructions to turn off your outside water valve (except the few buildings still to be soft washed)

BY NOVEMBER 15 - *Please* – in order to avoid frozen pipes and to allow Maintenance to start installing faucet protectors on the hose bibs:

- 1. turn off the water to your outside hose bibs from the inside shut off,
- 2. remove any hoses that are attached,
- 3. drain the water that may be in the line and
- 4. leave the faucet open.
