May 2025 Board Meeting Recap

May's Board Meeting was held May 19, 2025, at 7:00. Many thanks to the community members who joined us in person and by phone!

The Pool is Open!

- The concrete portion of the pool deck is completed, and the plank decking will be replaced in the fall.
- Enjoy the new picnic tables!
- A reminder—no pool floats or other large pool toys are allowed in the pool. Why? It's not a huge pool, and it's well loved and used. There simply isn't space. Queen's Landing has provided pool noodles (please leave them at the pool, they are not party favors to take home!)
- Fob not working? That means either your unit is behind in fees or does not have current maintenance documentation on file.

Breezeline May be Getting Some Competition

The Office is in discussion with Talkie and Comcast to wire Queen's Landing for internet/phone/TV. A decision should be made this fall. We do know that neither company would require a minimum enrollment to move forward, so no one has to change providers unless they want to. Stay tuned!

Financials Are Strong

Queen's Landing continues to enjoy a healthy balance sheet. Overall, we have a budget surplus of \$40K as of the end of March, mostly due to timing, seasonality, and accounting protocols.

Marina Happenings

- The Board approved the Charter of the Marina Executive Committee, also known as the Board of the Queen's Landing Community Marina, LLC.
- The Board also approved a motion to participate in the cost of repairing the channel bulkhead, with \$25k to be paid in 2025. The Board will consider additional payment to QLMC once all costs are known for full pool deck renovation.

Balconies and Decks

Of the 131 units that need balcony/deck repairs, approximately 75 are completed (thank you!), 33 have provided proof of contract (thank you!), and 15 are being managed by Queen's Landing. We need to get to 80% (108 units) before we can resubmit to FNMA.

Be in the Know!

We get it, it can be overwhelming dealing with all the emails you get every day. It's tempting to block or delete most of them. HOWEVER, you really don't want to delete or block emails from Queen's Landing, or from First Service Residential—these messages always have important information that as a resident here, you need to know.

• Every Thursday, a **Weekly Digest** is sent out via email from First Service Residential. It includes everything you need to know. However, if you opt out of these emails, you risk being in the dark.

• Did you know you can have several email addresses in your portal profile? Perhaps you want a son or daughter to be aware of what's happening in Queen's Landing. You can easily go into the portal to add this information.

• Make sure we have your correct email address, and that these emails are not going to your spam folder!

• Come to the monthly **Board Meeting**! It's held every third Monday of the month at 7:00 pm, and you can attend in person or dial in. We want to hear from you—the good, the bad, the ugly. Our only request is that you be respectful to your neighbors, and to your volunteer Board.

• Our **standing committees welcome** your talents, interest and ideas. There is no better way to stay connected and have a say than to join a committee. Unless, of course, you join the Board!

Windows and Doors and Work Orders, Oh My!

There are currently 119 open Work Orders. Average time to close work orders is 27 days. About half of the workorders are for windows and doors – all of which were inspected last week and a plan is being developed to address these.
